

3. Emergency Kit YOUR NEEDS & SUPPLIES

- 1. Determine the number of people and duration each kit will need to accommodate
- 2. Supply each kit for 3-7 day use
- 3. Determine type of kit needed (ie. shelter in place, vehicle evacuation, etc.)
- 4. Create a supply list based on household size, days of use, kit type, and number of kits
- 5. Acquire supplies piecemeal OR as prefabricated kits from a retailer





3. EMERGENCY KIT ASSEMBLE & STORE

 Assemble kits in airtight bags and place in containers, totes, duffel bags, and backpacks

FIRST AND KIT

- Keep pets, babies, elderly and other special needs in mind when packing
- Create multiple kits for different forms of seasonal readiness (winter, flood, wildfire)



 Keep each kit in a high and dry location that the whole household knows



When To Update Your Kit?



Check kits every 6-12 months for storage damage or expired items



Adjust kits as disaster risks evolve and household changes



Update as new technology advances



Place duplicate backup kits in different locations
