Getting Started

- 🟶 Sketch Your Landscape Plan & Design
- Space out plants to grow and produce properly
- Use containers to add visual texture
- Create a sun and shade map
- Check self-pollinating plants vs. ones that need a partner to fruit
- Group plants with similar heights, colors, patterns
- Research seasonality of plants and survival
- Label you plants and give it lots of attention



Types of Plants



- 1. Perennials Asparagus, Garlic, Lettuce, etc.
- 2. Herbs Basil, Lavender, Oregano, Thyme
- 3. Berry Bushes Strawberry, Blueberry, etc.
- 4. Fruit and Nut Trees
